

Programme Update



Ramping up for full production
Brazilian and Swedes working side by side

Close to deliveries

- both Sweden and Brazil this year
- Military Type Certificate
 - verification and declaration
 - continued tactical development
 - delivery of the complete weapon system



Flight test

- Three test sites in two countries
- Joint test and verification together with the customers
- 10 000 flight tests reached

Offer to Finland includes:

- Fighters and AEW&C
- Substantial weapons package
- Security of supply with an extensive Industrial Participation (IP)



Saab forecasts a market for some 300 to 450 Gripen over the next 20 years.

Canada

Sweden has provided a comprehensive response to the Canadian RFP. The requirement is for 88 aircraft.

Colombia

Saab has submitted a response to an RFP from the Colombian Air Force, offering 15 new Gripen E/F aircraft, including a technology transfer package.

India
