- Final stages of development
 - several serial production aircraft coming up
- Ramping up for full production
 - Brazilian and Swedes working side by side
- Close to deliveries
 - both Sweden and Brazil this year
- Military Type Certificate
 - verification and declaration
 - continued tactical development
 - delivery of the complete weapon system

- Three test sites in two countries
- Joint test and verification together with the customers
- 10 000 flight tests reached

Canada

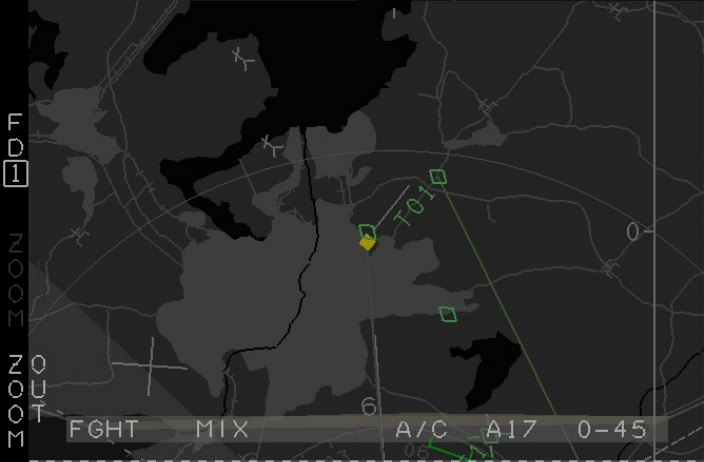
